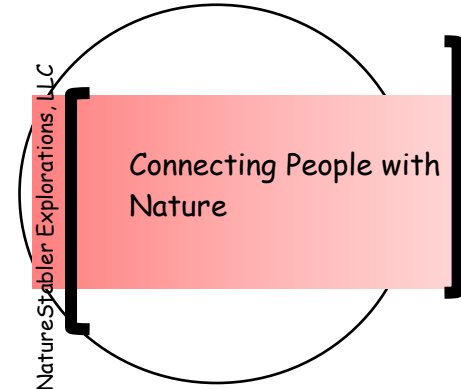

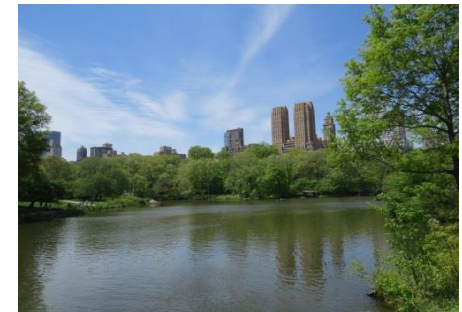

Bring along a pair of binoculars, rain gear and walking shoes/boots. This is a great opportunity for experienced and novice birders to experience vast numbers of birds!
